German precision is everywhere in the clean lines and immaculate finishes.

Filled with bright light, flowing out to a view of the ocean, this kitchen has been designed with coastal living in mind. Design details are absolutely everywhere: port holes at eye level set above the marble splash-black, and an intricate, floral, tin façade on the back of the kitchen bench, which is covered in cool marble.

But it's super functional too. The roller cupboard means everything you use frequently, like toasters and kettles, can be accessed quickly from the bench top.

The pantry has deep, smooth-close drawers and holds more than a tardis! Bottles of wine, pantry staples - everything you need for a minimum of supermarket visits. ①
